Preparing for Surgery



FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS FOR ELECTIVE SURGERY:

HOME PREPARATION FOR SURGERY:

- □ No food after 12:00 AM the night BEFORE surgery.
- Free-choice water should remain available at all times.
- □ Drop-off between 8:00-8:30 AM, morning of procedure.

WHEN PET IS ADMITTED:

- Be sure to tell us about anything concerning pet we should know before surgery.
- Ask us any questions you might have.
- Provide up to date contact information.
- Remind us any medication your pet is on long term and when last dose was given.

Pets receive a pre-surgical physical examination to determine health status. You will also be offered pre-operative blood test these tests evaluate the health of your pet's internal organs and may reveal problems not apparent by external exams. Pre-operative blood work is particularly recommended if your pet seems unhealthy in any way, and is required for all pets over seven years old.

*You will be called prior to surgery if the exam or blood tests reveal any problems.
