Preparing for Surgery



FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS FOR ELECTIVE SURGERY:

HOME PREPARATION FOR SURGERY:

- □ No food after 12:00 AM the night BEFORE surgery.
- □ Free-choice water should remain available at all times.
- Drop-off between 8:00-8:30 AM, morning of procedure.

WHEN PET IS ADMITTED:

- □ Be sure to tell us about anything concerning pet we should know before surgery.
- □ Ask us any questions you might have.
- □ Provide up to date contact information.
- □ Remind us any medication your pet is on long term and when last dose was given.

Pets receive a pre-surgical physical examination to determine health status. You will also be offered pre-operative blood test these tests evaluate the health of your pet's internal organs and may reveal problems not apparent by external exams. Pre-operative blood work is particularly recommended if your pet seems unhealthy in any way, and is required for all pets over seven years old.

You will be called prior to surgery if the exam or blood tests reveal any problems.
